Our Dragons participated in the 27th year of the "Metrocrest Summer League". We had five teams participate and approximately 60 guys involved. Summer league is a chance for our players to bond and develop chemistry while playing in competitive games. We also had several guys participate in the Grapevine "Gym Rats" Summer League.

The Varsity group was 10-5 in Metrocrest play and advanced to the "Sweet 16" in the end of season tournament. Adam Gerhart coached them this summer. The JV group had an outstanding record of 11-1 in league play. The Sophomore and Freshman groups all competed very hard in league play with great success.

On June 13-15 the Varsity group participated in the University of Texas Team Camp in Austin. Our record at Camp was 6-2.

### ATHLETIC PERIODS/PERFORMANCE COURSE

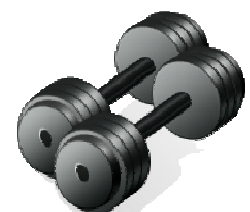

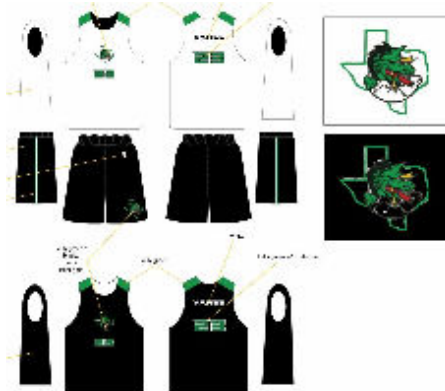
## PRACTICE GEAR
